- 9 O Lord, save the king: and hear us when we call upon you.

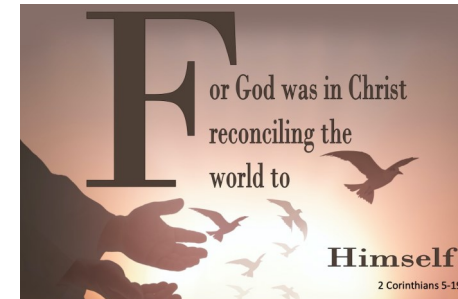
