Reflection

Today's gospel sees Jesus healing a woman with a kind of haemorrhagic disease as well as Jairus' daughter who was at the point of death. Jesus tells the woman that her faith has made her whole and he tells Jairus not to fear, but rather, to believe. He says to the girl, Talitha cum – little girl, get up, in Aramaic. That phrase still means the same thing to those who speak Assyrian, otherwise known as neo -Aramaic, in the streets of Fairfield and surrounding suburbs in Sydney. Members of the Assyrian Church of the East, whose historic patriarchate is based in Iraq, now live in significant numbers in Sydney and Melbourne.

- Pray for the Church's healing ministry through the Guild of St Raphael, and though hospitals and clinics throughout the Anglican Communion.
- Give thanks for the witness of St George's College in East Jerusalem, praying that they will be able to withstand the lack of student pilgrims because of their dearth at this time of fighting
