1 My God, my God, why have you forsaken me: why are you
so far from helping me and from the words of my groaning?

2 **My God, I cry to you by day, but you do not answer: and by night also I take no rest.**

3 But you continue holy: you that are the praise of Israel.

4 **In you our forebears trusted: they trusted, and you delivered them;**

5 To you they cried and they were saved: they put their trust in you and were not confounded.

6 **But as for me, I am a worm and no man: the scorn of all and despised by the people.**

7 Those that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out their lips at me and wag their heads, saying,

8 **'He trusted in the Lord—let him deliver him: let him deliver him, if he delights in him.'**

9 But you are he that took me out of the womb: that brought me to lie at peace on my mother's breast.

10 **On you have I been cast since my birth: you are my God, even from my mother's womb.**

11 O go not from me, for trouble is hard at hand: and there is none to help.

12 **Many oxen surround me: fat bulls of Bashan close me in on every side.**

13 They gape wide their mouths at me: like lions that roar and rend.

14 **I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint:
my heart within my breast is like melting wax.**

15 My mouth is dried up like a potsherd: and my tongue clings to my gums.
