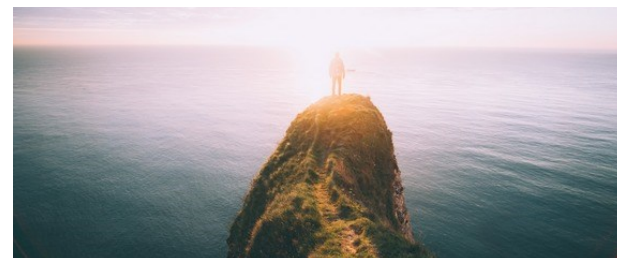

Reflection
